THREE LEVELS OF RECOGNITION

A professional pathway built around management practice.

Begin with accessible chartered standing, progress through advanced managerial judgement and ultimately enter the College of Fellows through sustained practice, scholarship and service.

01 · FOUNDATION

Chartered Associate Manager

Accessible first chartered rank for members building breadth, formalising ethical practice and developing a Primary Practice Domain.

Post-nominal: CAM

02 · ADVANCED PRACTICE

Chartered Professional Manager

MMI's principal professional designation for experienced managers and consultants who demonstrate consequential judgement through an applied case.

Post-nominal: CPM

03 · FELLOWSHIP

Fellow of the MMI

The pre-eminent MMI distinction for practising managers whose standing is strengthened by scholarship, contribution and stewardship.

Post-nominal: FMI

Recognition grounded in practice.

Education provides the pathway; professional standing is awarded through membership, experience, ethics, evidence, formal review and continuing development.

CHARTERED ASSOCIATE MANAGER

Build recognised standing in management practice.

CAM is designed as an accessible first chartered rank. It recognises members who are strengthening their professional breadth, developing a clear Primary Practice Domain and seeking recognised standing at the start of their chartered pathway.
